What counts as each allergen

Prompts for the most common hiding places. Not a complete list: check every ingredient specification and every supplier change.

Allergen	Where it commonly hides
Celery	Stalks, leaves, seeds, celeriac. Stock, soup, salad.
Cereals with gluten	Wheat, rye, barley, oats, spelt, kamut. Flour, batter, breadcrumbs, soy sauce.
Crustaceans	Prawns, crab, lobster, langoustine, scampi, shrimp paste.
Eggs	Mayonnaise, custard, glaze, some pasta, meringue.
Fish	Fish sauce, anchovy in dressings, Worcestershire sauce.
Lupin	Lupin flour and seeds, sometimes in bread and pastry.
Milk	Butter, cheese, cream, yoghurt, milk powder, ghee.
Molluscs	Mussels, clams, oysters, squid, snails, oyster sauce.
Mustard	Seeds, powder, paste, many dressings and marinades.
Peanuts	Peanut oil, satay, some sauces and baked goods.
Sesame	Seeds, tahini, houmous, burger buns, some oils.
Soybeans	Tofu, edamame, soy sauce, miso, some vegetable proteins.
Sulphites	Declarable above 10 mg/kg or 10 mg/L. Dried fruit, wine, some processed meat.
Tree nuts	Almond, hazelnut, walnut, cashew, pecan, Brazil, pistachio, macadamia.
